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I. Introduction

Overview of the Adams County Youth Initiative

Initiated in 2005, by 17th Judicial District Attorney Don Quick, the Adams County Youth Initiative (ACYI) is a countywide collaborative committed to decreasing delinquency and substance use and increasing high school graduation rates in youth populations through evidence-based programs and strategies.

Largely due to the foundational work of ACYI, Adams County was awarded a 5-year (2007-12), \$8 million federally-funded Safe Schools/Healthy Students grant (SS/HS) to serve children birth to age 21 and their families in Adams 12 Five Star Schools, Adams 14, School District 27J, Adams County School District 50, and Mapleton Public Schools.

Through ACYI and SS/HS, a consortium of 26 partner agencies (including school districts, law enforcement, mental health, human services, juvenile justice, community health, work force development, and the local early childhood council) are now working together to improve the coordination of resources in Adams County in order to promote the health and well-being of children and families. Partners agree that a collaborative approach is needed in Adams County to most effectively and efficiently accomplish these mutual goals:

- Develop a more coordinated system of services and supports for children (birth to age 21) and their families through strategic agency partnerships and collaborations.
- Provide stronger advocacy and leadership so that Adams County will be best positioned to receive and utilize available public and private funding opportunities.

Evaluation and the Adams County Youth Initiative

Evaluation is a critical component of the Initiative. Through a rigorous countywide assessment, it is possible to ensure that grant resources are tied to actual school needs. Furthermore, on-going annual evaluation provides evidence that activities and programs funded by the Adams County Youth Initiative have a significant impact on student behaviors. The Adams County Student Survey, which was administered in the fall semesters of 2008 and 2009 to all students in grades 6 through 12 in the five Adams County school districts listed above, is the primary evaluation instrument for the Adams County Youth Initiative. Collectively, the data from these surveys comprise a comprehensive school, district, and county assessment that will measure the long-term impact of the grant activities on youth behaviors and outcomes.

Using the Student Survey Data to Set Priorities at the School and District Level

The data obtained through the Adams County Student Survey are intended to be used by school and district administrators gain a better understanding of their strengths and challenges. This report provides countywide data grouped by Grades 6-8, 9-12, and 6-12. The appendix provides a complete countywide breakdown by grade. This is the only countywide information that will be released publicly.

Each school superintendent in the districts listed above received district and school level reports comparing each school to their district and to Adams County in aggregate. This information will enable schools and districts to set priorities for action based on these comparisons. The Adams County Youth Initiative staff will work with school districts to assist in matching grant resources to the school needs identified through the survey. Over time, the survey data will help Adams County to prioritize which activities are worth sustaining and provide evidence of their value to potential funders.

Each of the five school district superintendents has appointed a member to the ACYI Steering Committee to represent their respective districts. These representatives are very knowledgeable about the Adams County Youth Initiative and its programmatic offerings. Their names and titles follow:

II. Methods and Survey Sample

Methods

Surveys were administered via paper Scantron forms to students in classroom settings between September and November 2009 (2008 administration occurred between October and December 2008). Passive consent was obtained from parents via a letter notifying them of their child's right not to participate in the survey. All students in grades six through 12 in Mapleton Public Schools, Adams 12 Five Star Schools, Adams 14, Adams 27J, and Adams 50 were invited to participate. Total enrollment for the schools in which we surveyed in these five districts was 36,079 as of October 1, 2009.

A district report and all school level reports have been given to each district superintendent through their Adams County Youth Initiative Steering Committee Representative for district dissemination. *All of these reports are considered confidential by the Adams County Youth Initiative staff and the local evaluator and are clearly marked confidential on these documents.* The only information that will be released publicly is the countywide aggregate. It is up to the discretion of districts and schools to determine how or if their data will be released publicly.

Response Rates and Survey Sample Characteristics

Response Rates: In the fall of 2009, 27,770 students completed the Adams County Student Survey in Adams County. The response rate for the county was 77%. This met the targeted 75% response rate. A high response rate is preferred in survey research in order to achieve adequate power to demonstrate changes from one year to the next and to ensure that the sample that took part in the survey is representative of the larger population that was surveyed (i.e., all students). Whether differences exist between those students who responded to the survey compared to those who did not is not known. Therefore, care must be taken in generalizing the results to the entire school population when response rates are lower than 70 to 75%.

Survey Sample Characteristics: The gender distribution of the students surveyed was 49% male and 51% female. Ninety-nine percent of the students who responded to the survey in Adams County completed the survey in English, though a Spanish version was made available.

When asked if students were being honest on this survey, 94% of students agreed. Very consistent data from 2008 to 2009 also confirms the reliability of student survey responses. An investigation into the "extreme responders" to the Adams County Youth Survey yields a note of caution. In 2009, approximately 250 respondents (fewer than 1% of the total) were classified as "extreme responders" given that they reported very high frequencies of use among all the substance use questions. However, given that similar "extreme responders" are not removed from the comparison data from the Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance Survey (YRBS),¹ their responses were left in for the purposes of these reports.

The following charts and tables present, in more detail, the demographic makeup of the students who responded to the 2009 Adams County Student Survey.

Chart 1. Student Survey Response Rate by District and Adams County, 2008 and 2009

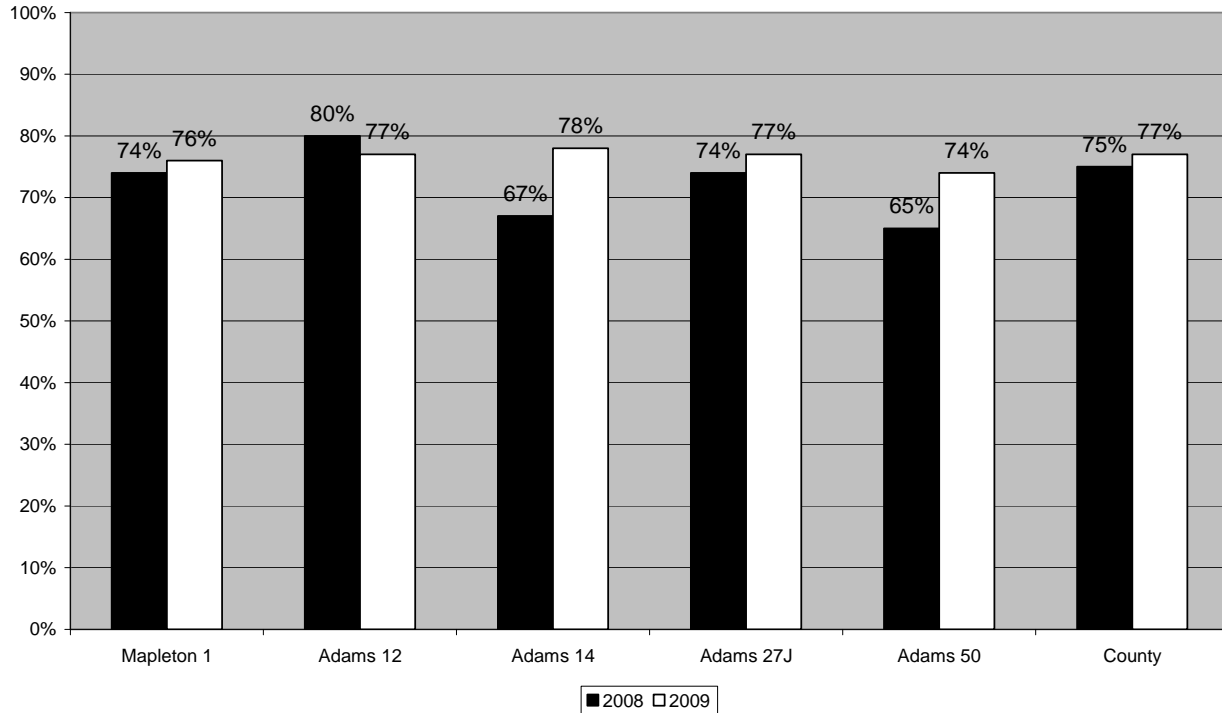
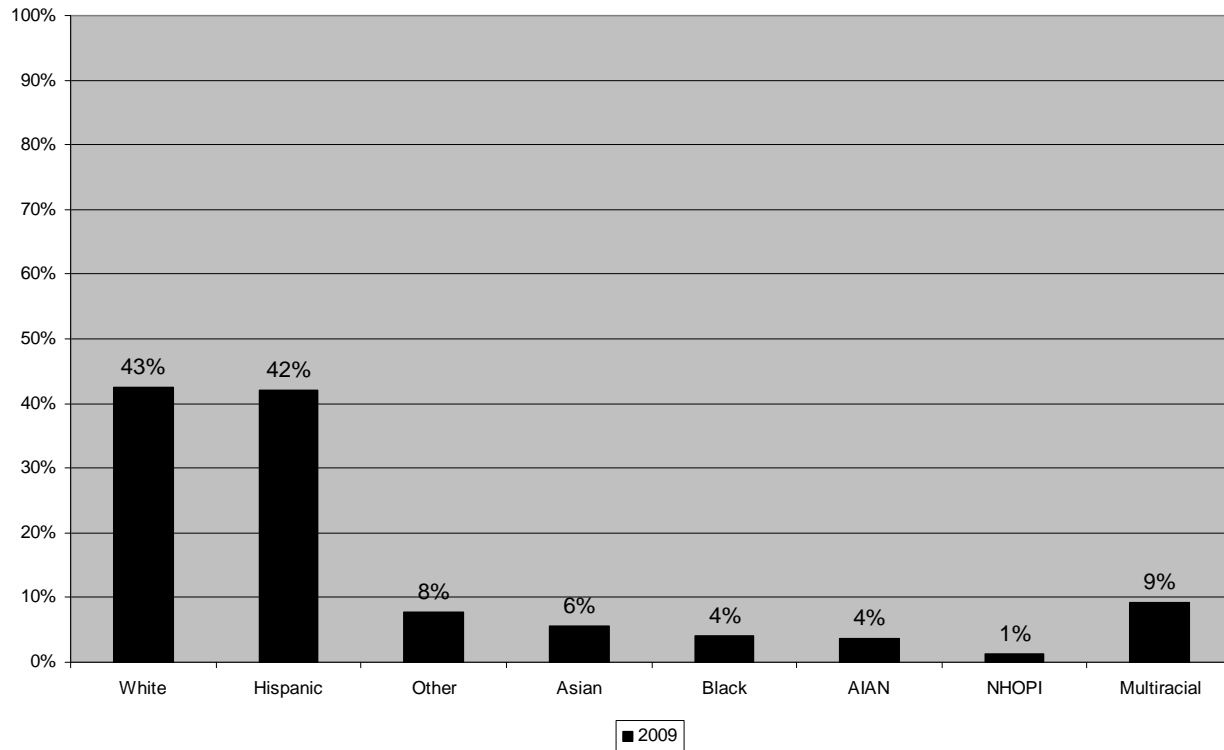

III. Student Survey Results

Students' Bullying Behaviors

For many reasons, bullying is an issue at the forefront in today's schools. Left unaddressed, bullying can leave children and teenagers feeling depressed and alone. For some, the effects of bullying can last a lifetime. Victims have an increased chance of academic failure, low self-esteem and inability to connect socially. There are long-term implications for the bullies, too. Research shows that those who bully typically have a criminal record by age 24.²

The first five items in the table show the students who reported being a victim of bullying, one or more times, during the past 12 months. The final item shows the proportion of students who responded "yes" to being the victim of a verbal slur because of their weight, size, gender, or appearance during the past 30 days.³

Table 3 shows the students who reported being a perpetrator of bullying at least one time during the past 12 months.⁴ National comparison data at the high school level is available for the following question, “Were you in a physical fight on school property?” In 2007, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimated that 12% of high school students in the United States reported being in a fight on school property.⁵

Students' Perceptions of School Safety

Research shows a positive school climate is essential for developing a safe school. Students' perceptions of school safety are likely to be related to the school climate. Factors impacting school climate may include student involvement, student relationships, teacher support, the physical environment of the school, knowledge and fairness of school discipline policies, participation in decision-making, access to counseling services, and the school's level of emergency preparedness. In 2007, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimated that 5.5% of high school students in the United States reported that they did not go to school because they felt unsafe at school or on their way to or from school.⁶

A safe school requires balancing physical security with a nurturing school climate, as well as developing effective school and community partnerships.⁷ The countywide partnerships created through the Adams County Youth Initiative are intended to support schools in this effort.

Table 4 reflects data specifically about students' perceptions of school safety.

Students' Reporting of Threatening Behavior

In 82% of violent incidents in U.S. schools, someone other than the attacker knew it was going to happen, but failed to report it.⁸ Following the school shooting tragedies at Columbine, Bailey, and throughout the nation, it became evident that students needed an anonymous way to report suspicions. The following survey questions were added in 2009 to measure whether Adams County students were willing to report any threatening behaviors or activities endangering themselves or someone they know.

Table 5 details students' willingness to report threats at their school.

Gang Involvement

Gang activity has been identified as a growing issue in Adams County and in the State of Colorado. Of the admissions to Colorado's Youth Offender System (YOS) in 2009, 77% had a gang status. This is considerably higher than the 31% seen among all YOS admissions since its inception in 1994.⁹ Adams County is second only to Denver County in the number of youth commitments to the YOS. To better understand the prevalence of gangs within Adams County, the Student Survey provides three self-report measures relating to youths' perceptions of gangs.

Table 6 reflects the percentage of students who answered "Yes" to the questions regarding gang involvement.

Weapons

Student weapon carrying provides another important indicator that is likely to impact school safety. Students carrying weapons on school property may cause physical injury and death among students and school staff. Additionally, the learning environment within schools is interrupted if there is confirmed or suspected carrying of weapons by students. In 2007, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimated that 5.9% of high school students in the United States reported carrying a weapon such as a gun, knife or club on school property.¹⁰

Table 7 refers to experiences with weapons in the past 30 days by students completing the survey. Percentages reflect the number of students who answered at least one day to the questions.¹¹

Substance Use

In 2007, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention found that 45% of high school students nationwide had at least one drink of alcohol in the past 30 days and 20% used marijuana in the past 30 days.¹²

Implementing evidence-based programs and strategies to target the major social and psychological factors that promote the initiation of substance use and other risky behaviors is critical to reducing the risks of alcohol, tobacco, and drug abuse.

Table 8 refers to substance use in the past 30 days by students who completed the survey. Percentages shown reflect the number of students who answered using the substance on at least one day during that time period. Derbisol is a fictitious drug used by researchers to test the validity of self-report data. The low proportion of students reporting derbisol use supports the validity of the self-report substance use data.

Perceptions of Other Students' Substance Using Behaviors

In addition to asking students to report on their own tobacco, alcohol and drug use, the 2009 survey asks students to estimate their peers' use of these substances. The questions were adapted from survey materials made available by the National Social Norms Resource Center. The social norms approach to health promotion has evolved from the ever-increasing body of research documenting students' misperceptions of peer norms.

Social norms programs seek to change students' behavior by educating them on the actual frequency of certain peer behaviors, which are typically below the perceived amount. By asking Adams County students about their behaviors, as well as those of their peers, information can be obtained to tailor a specific social norms approach for Adams County students.

In the previous section, students reported their substance use behavior. Table 9 details their perception of the frequency of these behaviors for "a typical student" at their school. Students overwhelmingly overestimate their peers' substance use. And, while a very small percentage of students report using the fictitious drug derbisol¹³ themselves, they estimate over one quarter of their peers to be using this drug, despite the fact that most have probably never heard of it.

Students were asked to select, from a list, what they typically drink when hanging out with friends, and then were asked to provide this same information for their peers. Table 10 shows that students typically overestimate their classmates choosing beverages like alcohol and energy drinks and underestimate their use of healthier choices such as water and juice.

Table 11 shows that most of the students surveyed would rather date other students who do not drink, smoke or use drugs. These results indicate another positive finding that could be promoted through a social norm campaign.

Youth Civic Engagement

Increasing opportunities for civic engagement and participation in a variety of prosocial activities are important strategies for helping youth to acquire the skills, attitudes, and values that will propel them forward into academic achievement and a productive adult life. Youth who participate in community or civic engagement projects are more likely to be engaged in school and to have higher goals for postsecondary education. They are also more likely to become essential contributors to the civic infrastructure of their community.

Table 12 illustrates civic engagement.

Out-of-School Time Opportunities

High-quality after school and summer programming stimulates positive youth development by providing enriching social, physical, and intellectual activities. After school programs impact student safety, social skills, engagement in learning, and higher academic performance. Recent research from Johns Hopkins University shows that two-thirds of the achievement gap in reading can be attributed solely to unequal summer learning opportunities.¹⁴ The Adams County Youth Initiative aims to design and implement a comprehensive system of out-of-school time opportunities for youth in Adams County.

Table 13 reflects data specifically about students' experiences with after school opportunities. Table 14 shows the types of activities in which students said they were interested in participating. The last question in Table 13 and all the questions in Table 14 were new to the Student Survey in 2009.

Student Physical Activity

Over the past thirty years, the prevalence of overweight has doubled among preschool-aged children and adolescents and tripled among children aged 6 to 11. Childhood obesity is the top health problem facing children in the United States. Causes of this epidemic include decreased levels of physical activity, increasingly sedentary lifestyles, and poor eating habits. According to the 2008 Physical Activity Guidelines for Americans, children and adolescents should do 1 hour or more of physical activity every day.

Table 15 reflects the percentage of students who are physically active.
